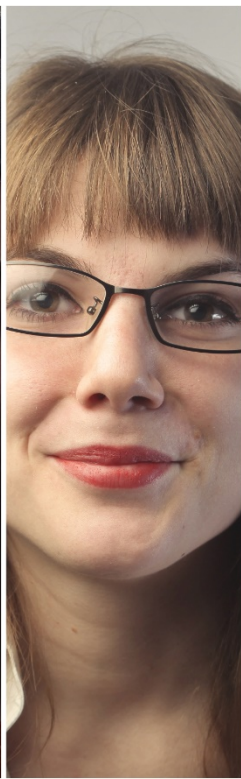

2-year Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment grant: Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention and Prescriber Education



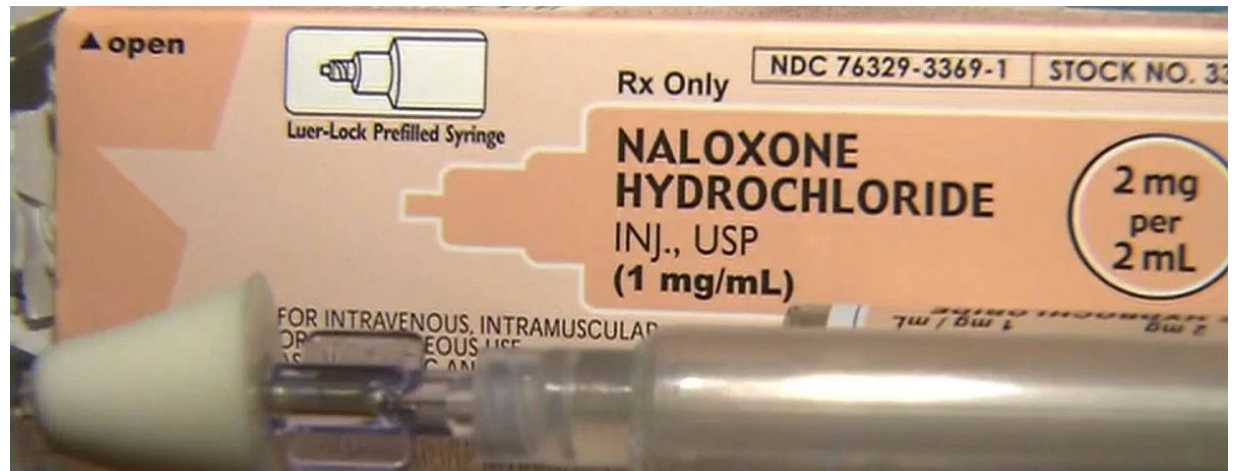
3-year SAMHSA Grant: Hub-and-Spoke Model to Expand Medication Assisted Treatment in Northern Colorado



2-year Colorado Health Foundation Grant to transform approach to SUDs in Criminal Justice System and community mental health treatment



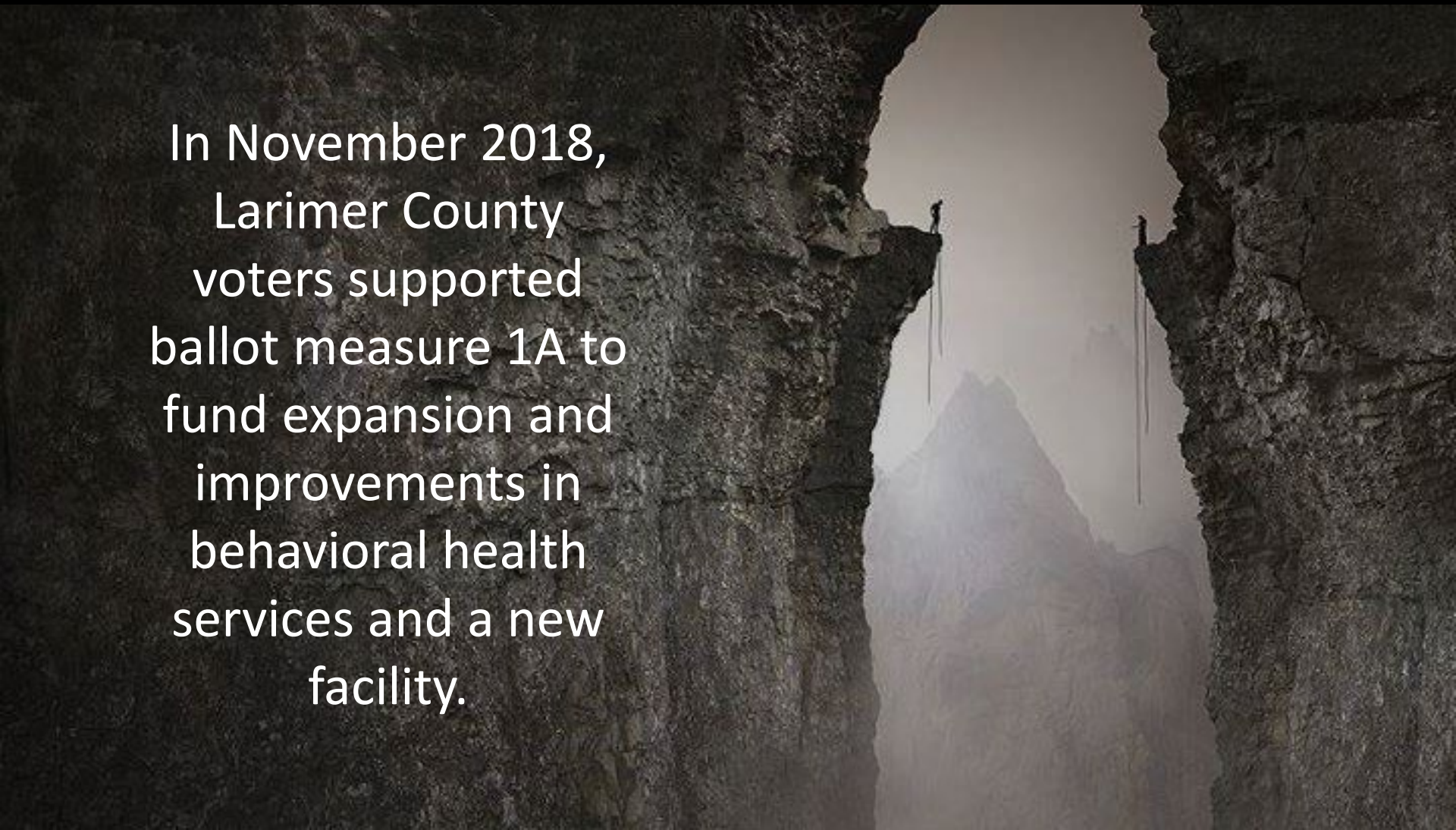
Jail-Based Medication Assisted Treatment to begin in 2019



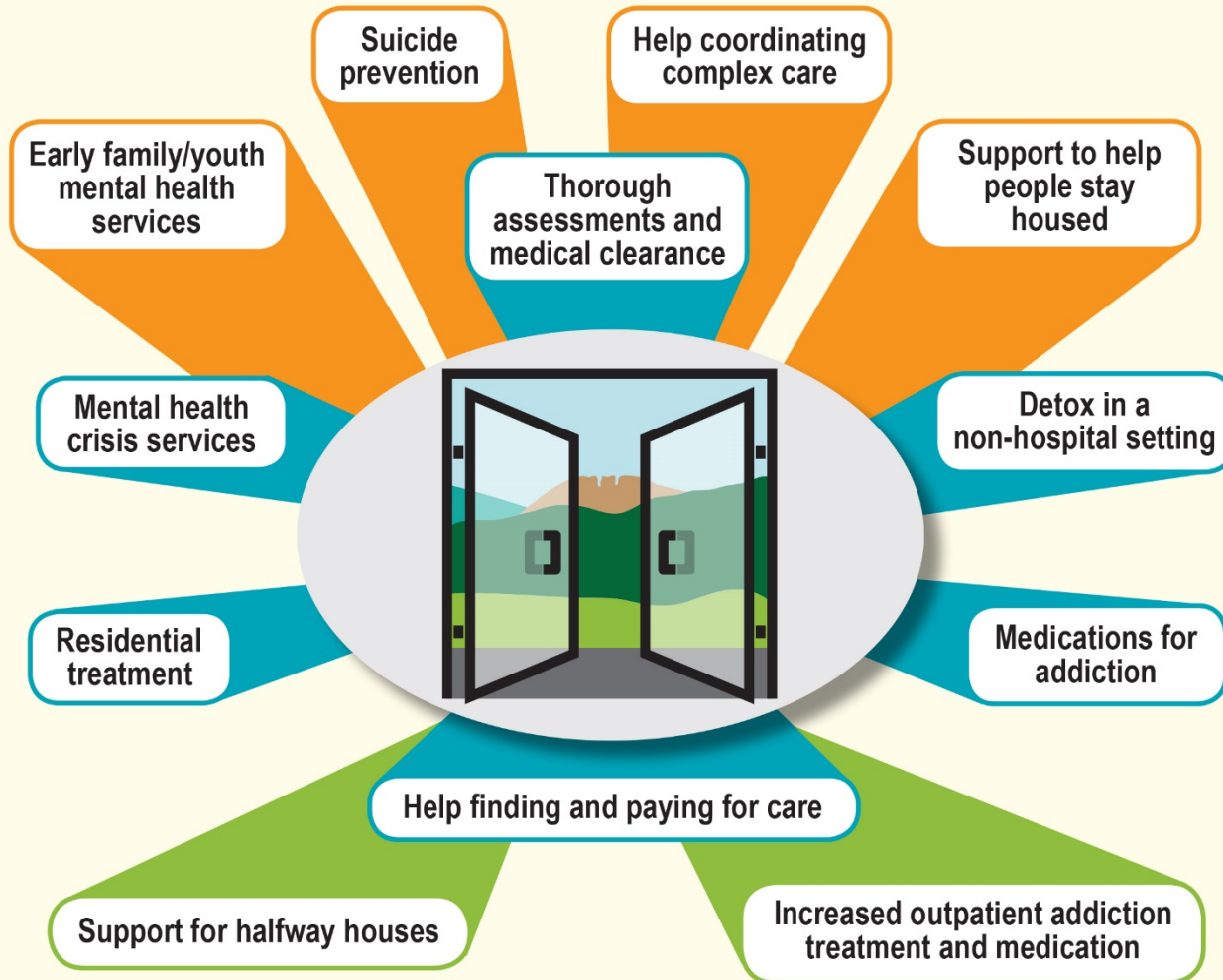
