Key points from the Health Care in Your Future Summit

Graduation requirements for University Schools students include at least 3 half-day shadowing experiences and at least fifty hours of internship participation.

Students in health care careers may participate in hands-on shadowing experiences with Aims Community College in areas of radiation technology, sterile processing, surgery technology and mannequin labs. Senior students may participate in an academic year long Aims med prep program where they can receive up to 6 health care certifications.

The Centennial Area Health Education Center is a hosting site for the H.O.P.E. Program (Health Occupations Promoting Equity). Students who attend the 6 monthly health seminars are eligible for consideration to attend all expense paid health careers summer camp at CU Boulder or Colorado Springs. Summer camp includes three days on the Anschutz medical campus.
